- If your status as a Focus Awards recognised centre is suspended or withdrawn or ended by you as a recognised centre, you must stop using the logo immediately.
- The logo may not be amended in any way, including resizing or reduction of quality. If you experience difficulty with the logo size or shape please contact Centre Support
- The logo is not a sign of recognition and must not be used in webpages or material that could infer that a firm is regulated by Focus Awards if they are not a recognised centre.
